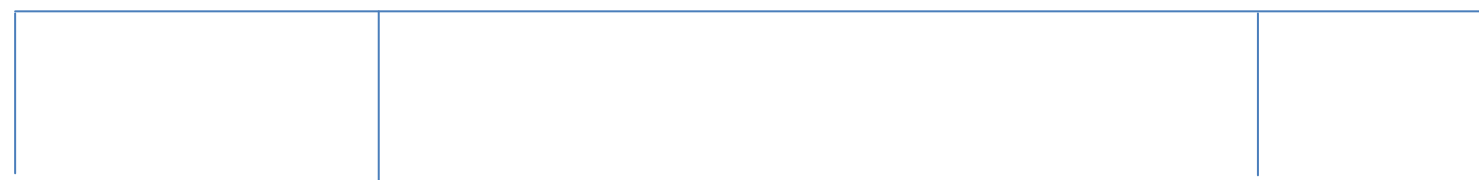
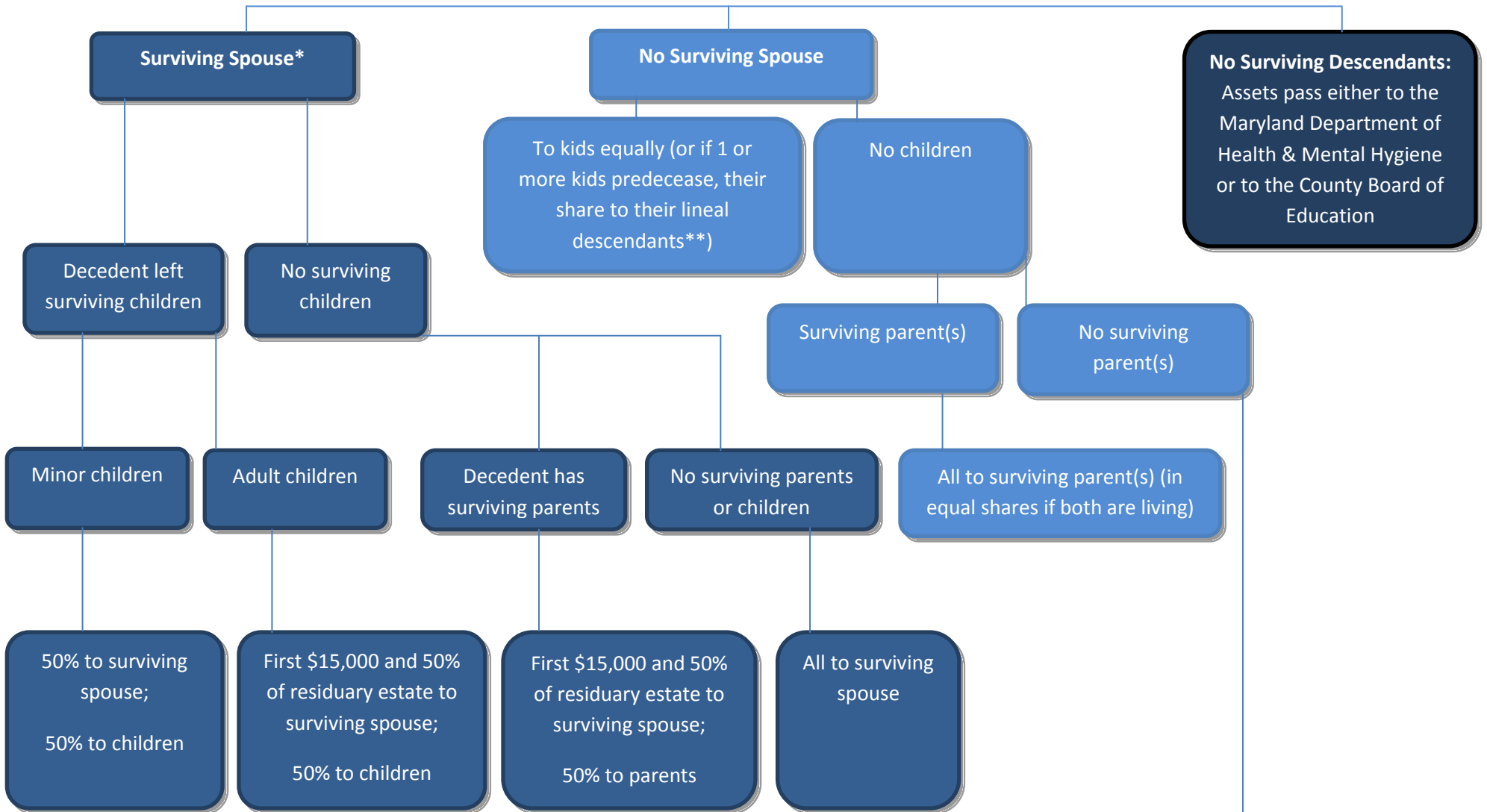
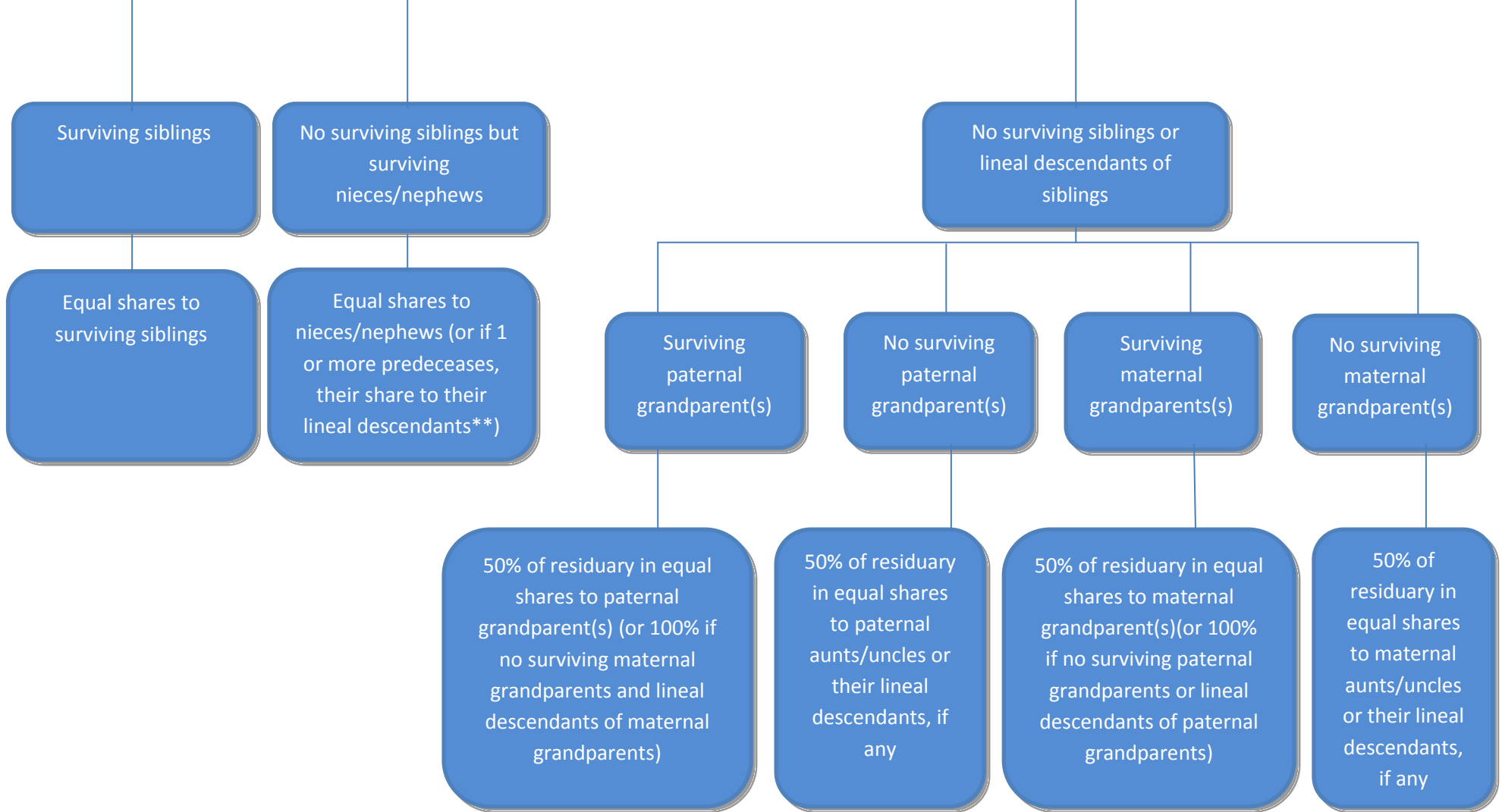


Under Maryland Law, If a Decedent Dies Without a Will, Who Receives Assets After Probate Concludes?
